

Chromebook Loan Agreement

Heath Lane Academy

1. Ownership and Responsibility

- The Chromebook remains the property of Heath Lane Academy at all times.
- The device may be recalled by the Academy at any time, without prior notice or explanation.
- The device is issued to a named pupil and must only be used by that pupil. Sharing the device is not permitted.
- The Chromebook must be returned immediately upon request, at the end of the loan period, or when the pupil leaves the Academy.

2. Usage Guidelines

- The Chromebook must be used in accordance with Heath Lane Academy's Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) and Online Safety Policy.
- The device is intended for educational use only. Personal or recreational use is discouraged and may be subject to monitoring.
- No unauthorised software, extensions, or applications may be installed.
- Pupils must not attempt to remove or bypass security settings, filters, or device management systems (e.g. using VPNs or developer mode).
- It is the pupil's responsibility to ensure the device is charged and ready for use during the school day.

3. Security and Data Protection

- Pupil login credentials must be kept secure and must not be shared with others.
- Internet usage on the Chromebook may be monitored or filtered by the Academy, both on and off school premises.
- Pupils must not store any personal, sensitive, or confidential data on the device unless specifically advised to do so by staff and with appropriate protection.
- When not in use, the Chromebook must be stored in a safe and secure location.

4. Loss, Damage and Care

- Pupils are expected to take reasonable care of the device and avoid behaviour that could lead to loss or damage.
- Any damage, loss or theft must be reported to the Academy immediately. If the device is stolen outside of school, it must also be reported to the police, and a crime reference number provided.
- Pupils must not attempt to repair, open, or modify the device in any way.
- The Academy reserves the right to seek reimbursement for repair or replacement costs if damage or loss results from negligence or failure to take proper care.

5. Deposit and Charges

- A £50 deposit has been collected from most parents/carers. This deposit will be held by the Academy for the duration of the loan.
- The Deposit will be refunded in full following final inspection when the device and
 accessories are returned in satisfactory condition, typically when the pupil leaves the
 Academy.
- If damage is caused by negligence or misuse and the cost of repair or replacement exceeds the deposit amount, parents/carers may be required to pay the difference.
- Parents/carers who have not paid the deposit will be liable for the full cost of any repair
 or replacement caused by negligence, misuse, or failure to return the device and/or
 accessories.
- No charges will be made for faults due to normal wear and tear or manufacturer defects.

6. Inspection and Return

- The Chromebook may be inspected by Academy staff at any time.
- All equipment issued (including the Chromebook, charger, and protective case) must be returned in good condition when requested, or when the pupil leaves Heath Lane Academy.
- Missing or damaged accessories may incur replacement charges.

7. Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

- I understand that I am responsible for ensuring the safe and appropriate use of the Chromebook at home.
- I agree to support Heath Lane Academy in ensuring my child uses the device in line with the Academy's policies and expectations.
- I acknowledge the deposit arrangements and accept financial responsibility for any repair or replacement charges, as outlined above.

8. Agreement

 By signing the Loan Agreement, you confirm that you have read and understood the terms of this Chromebook Loan Agreement and agree to comply with all conditions set out above.
