Dear Parent/Carer,

Geography Field Trip to Hinckley

On Tuesday 28th October 2025, your child will be taking part in a Geography field trip to Hinckley. This is the second of two field trips that are needed to complete essential work for their GCSE Geography course.

Pupils will leave the school in small groups at different points in the school day and will travel to Hinckley by school minibus. Whilst in Hinckley, pupils will have approximately one hour to collect data from different locations linked to their GCSE course. Under the supervision of staff, pupils will be allowed to move around in small groups, to each designated area.

During the trip, pupils will be engaged in discussions and activities directly linked to their GCSE exam content. For this reason, their attendance is highly important.

Pupils are expected to be in full school uniform and should bring a suitable coat/jacket for working outdoors. Pupils are advised to bring a snack and a drink with them as the timings may overlap parts of break time and lunch. There will be no financial charge for the trip.

If you consent to your child participating in the trip, please ensure that the permission form is completed on Arbor no later than midday on **Monday 27th October 2025**. If permission is not completed, your child will remain in school.
